

Biography: Leo Fahey

Leo Fahey, democratic education activist and democratic school organizer began as a communication arts university instructor in 1980, changed in 1991 to teaching high school social studies and moved in 1999 to democratic education school development. He advised alternatives in Texas and Massachusetts before joining a school start-up group in New York City in 2003 which developed The Brooklyn Free School. Today, he continues promoting democratic education principles and counseling alternative start-ups in New York City as director of the Rockaway College Project.
